

**Notice of Making
Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984
Sheepway, Portbury, North Somerset
Prohibition of use by vehicles exceeding 17 tonnes maximum gross weight
order 2020
Ref: MGW/PORT/BDR**

Notice is hereby given that on 15 October 2020 North Somerset Council made an order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the effect of which was to prohibit any vehicle exceeding 17 tonnes maximum gross weight to enter or proceed in the length of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. The order came into operation on 19 October 2020.

Due to Covid 19 full details of the proposals are unavailable to view at Council buildings, the full details are contained in the Order, a Plan and a Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order can alternative be viewed online using the following website <https://www.n-somerset.gov.uk/notices> and online at Portbury Parish Council <http://www.parish-council.com/portbury/news.asp>

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in the order on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, may within six weeks after the date on which the order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles and Temporary Waiting or Loading
Restriction Order 2020
Date coming into force: 23 November 2020

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Notice; and to prohibit, temporarily, any vehicle from waiting or loading in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice. Exemptions that apply to the road closures are included for emergency services, Public Transport Buses and Authorised Recycling & Waste Collection Vehicles (to be escorted through the closure), works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road. Exemptions that apply to the Waiting or Loading Restriction are included for emergency services and works construction vehicles that are undertaking works in the restriction.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Gigaclear Limited to install fibre optic equipment (Contact Obelisk for Gigaclear 03454 349 992). This will become operative on **23 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in Claverham Road in two phases which is anticipated to be **21 days** in duration. The waiting and loading restriction on Stowey Park is required in the interests of public safety for the diversion and is anticipated to be **21 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule 1 closures - Claverham Road phase one from the junction of High Street/Frost Hill to the junction with Stowey Park. Claverham Road phase two from the junction with Stowey Park to outside St Dunstons and St Vincents Church.

Schedule 2 Waiting or Loading Restriction 24/7 for the duration of the associated works - Stowey Park on both sides of the road and for the extent of road from property number 1 to number 7 approximately. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water to repair a fire hydrant and connect a new supply. This will become operative on **14 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.
