Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order  
Bristol Road, Portishead, North Somerset  
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles  
Date coming into force: 16 November 2020

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

**This order** was required because of carriageway surfacing works and will become operative on **16 November 2020** for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 days** in duration.

**Schedule** – Bristol Road, Portishead from Travis Perkins to Ridgeview House.  
**Alternative route** - B3124 Bristol road (part unaffected), B3124 High Street, A369 Wyndham Way, B3124 Bristol road (part unaffected) and vice versa.

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to clear blockages and replace BT frame and cover (contact TLU for BT 01823 661 104). This will become operative on **21 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Schedule** - Currells Lane from junction of Dial Lane to Newditch Lane. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>

**Claverham Road, Stowey Park, Claverham, North Somerset**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles and Temporary Waiting or Loading**  
**Restriction Order 2020**  
**Date coming into force: 23 November 2020**  
**Ref: T20-542**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule 1 to this Notice; and to prohibit, temporarily, any vehicle from waiting or loading in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 to this notice. Exemptions that apply to the road closures are included for emergency services, Public Transport & School Buses and Authorised Recycling & Waste Collection Vehicles (to be escorted through the closure), works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road. Exemptions that apply to the Waiting or Loading Restriction are included for emergency services and works construction vehicles that are undertaking works in the restriction.

**This order** was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Gigaclear Limited to install fibre optic equipment (contact Obelisk for Gigaclear 03454 349 992). This will become operative on **23 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in Claverham Road in two phases which is anticipated to be **21 days** in duration. The waiting and loading restriction on Stowey Park is required in the interests of public safety for the diversion and is anticipated to be **21 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Schedule 1 closures:** Claverham Road Phase One from the junction of High Street/Frost Hill to the junction with Stowey Park. Claverham Road Phase Two from the junction with Stowey Park to outside St Dunstons & St Vincents Church.

**Schedule 2:** Waiting or Loading Restriction 24/7 for the duration of the associated works - Stowey Park on both sides of the road and for the extent of road from property number 1 to number 7 approximately. **Alternative routes** see <https://northsomerset.roadworks.org/>
