External works including internal road realignment, car parking and landscaping - at Thatcher's Cider Company Ltd, Myrtle Farm, Station Road, Sandford.

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

**This order** is required because of carriageway surfacing works and will become operative on **23 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of **4 weeks** from 23 November 2020 to 18 December 2020 (for 24 hours a day), **2 weeks** from 4 January 2021 to 15 January 2021 (for 24 hours a day), **1 week** from 18 January 2021 to 22 January 2021 between 8pm and 6am.

**Schedule** – Stockmead, Langford from its junction with Stock Lane to approximately 30m in north westerly direction. Stock Lane, Langford from its junction with Bypass (A38) to its junction with Langford Road, including the roundabout. **Alternative routes** - Bypass (A38), Station Road (A38), Red Hill (A38), Bristol Road (A38), Potters Hill (A38), Bridgwater Road (A38), Colliters Way (A4174), Long Ashton By-Pass (A370), Main Road (A370), Farleigh Road (A370), West Town Road (A370), Main Road (A370), Rhodyate Hill (A370), Bristol Road (A370), High Street (B3133), Brinsea Road (B3133), Stock Lane (B3133) part unaffected and vice versa

**Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020**  
**Baker Street, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020**  
**Date coming into force: 27 November 2020**  
**Ref: T20-540**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to undertake a new BT connection (contact Sunbelt Rentals for BT Openreach 03700 500 792). This will become operative on **27 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 day** in duration between approximately 9.30am and 3.30pm. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Schedule** - Baker Street at the junction with Stafford Road for approximately 38m.  
**Alternative routes** - Stafford Road, Beaufort Road, Swiss Road
