Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2020
Church Road, Lawrence Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2020
Date coming into force: 8 December 2020
Ref: T20-551

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT for safe access to install new fibre cable (contact Sunbelt Rentals for BT Openreach 03700 500 792). This will become operative on **8 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 night** in duration between approximately 9pm and 6am. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Church Road at the junction with Lawrence Road. Lawrence Road at the junction with Church Road. **Alternative routes** - Church Road, Spring Hill, Upper Bristol Road, Baytree Road, Milton Road, High Street, The Scaurs and vice versa.
