Road, Clevedon


KEY DECISION: NO

REASON:

The Decision will not result in the Authority incurring expenditure or making savings in excess of £500,000 and will not be significant in terms of its effect on communities living or working in more than one Ward in the area.

BACKGROUND:

The area of land shown edged red on the attached plan forms part of an area of highway land which was made subject to a Highways Stopping Up Order on 16 March 2020. The land is no longer required for highway purposes and no beneficial alternative Council use for the land has been identified following internal consultations with Council Officers.



DECISION:

To authorise Officers to dispose of the area of land shown edged red on the above plan.

REASONS:

To enable a beneficial alternative use of the land to be made by the adjoining private property owners and some financial benefit to be made by the Council for the land.

OPTIONS CONSIDERED:

The Council will benefit from a financial receipt on disposal of the land.

The Council will benefit from revenue savings in not having to maintain the land in future.
