**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

**This order** is required because of carriageway resurfacing and ancillary works and will become operative on **7 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **5 days** in duration between 8am and 5pm.

**Schedule** – Rayens Cross Road from the junction with Providence Lane for its full length. **Alternative routes** - Providence Lane, Keedwell Hill and vice versa.

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

**This order** is required because of carriageway surfacing works and will become operative on **27 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 day** in duration, between 8am and 5pm

**Date coming into force: 14 December 2020**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

**This order** was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Bristol Water to repair a fire hydrant and connect a new supply. This will become operative on **14 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **2 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

**Schedule** - Backwell Common outside properties Box Cottage, No.19 Backwell Common and Woolleys Farm (plot 1). **Alternative routes** - Backwell Common, Station Road, Farleigh Road, Backwell Hill Road, Chapel Hill, Backwell Bow and vice versa.

**20/P/2763/FUH** - Demolition of rear glazed lean-to extension and proposed erection of a rear single and two storey extension. Erection of a small front Porch and associated alterations to frontage; re-positioning of the front stone wall to create an off-road parking bay for 2no cars at Way Side, Quarry Road, Portishead.

**Listed Building Application**

**20/P/2556/FUL and 20/P/2557/LBC** - Conversion and part demolition of agricultural building (Unit 7) to create 1no. three bedroom residential dwelling at Gatcombe Farm, Gatcombe Lane, Flax Bourton.

**20/P/2589/FUL and 20/P/2590/LBC** - Listed building consent for the conversion and partial demolition of agricultural buildings (Units 4 & 5) to create a new detached dwelling at Gatcombe Farm, Gatcombe Lane, Flax Bourton.

**20/P/2491/LBC** - Listed building consent to undertake fire damage repairs to a barn including replacement of the roof covering and structure, reconstruction of stone walls and replacement of external doors at Oldeacre, North End Road, Yatton.
