Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Wales & West Utilities Ltd to install a new gas main. This will become operative on **7 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **12 days** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Falcon Crescent from junction Eagle Close to junction with Mead Vale.
Alternative routes - Mead Vale, Falcon Crescent and vice versa.

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the schedule to this notice.

This order is required because of carriageway resurfacing works and will become operative on **30 November 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of **four days** in duration between 8am and 5pm.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to install new fibre optics (contact Barden Network Engineering 01454 281 627 extension 210). This will become operative on **5 January 2021** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 night** in duration between approximately 7pm and 6.30am. Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles, the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order is required because of the need to implement social distancing measures for public safety in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. This order will become operative on **9 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the temporary prohibition may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated in response to the Covid-19 situation. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force. Exemptions are included for access to premises along the affected lengths, cyclists, emergency services, and works access.

Schedule - Sandmead Road, Sandford – from its junction with Nye Road, Sandford to its junction with Churchill Green, Churchill. Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to suspend, temporarily, the existing speed limit in favour restricting temporarily any vehicle to not exceeding 20mph, 30mph or 40mph in the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

This order is required for safety of pedestrians using Public Rights of Way AX29/51/10 and AX14/21/10 and Churchill Green to access Churchill Academy, and for the safety of cyclists using Nye Road, Sandmead Road and Churchill Green to access Churchill Academy and other properties on the affected lengths. This order will become operative on **9 December 2020** for a maximum period of 18 months. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Churchill Green, Churchill (20mph) in both directions from the entrance to Yew Tree House, Churchill Green for a distance of approximately 180m to the entrance to Churchill Academy's sports fields. **Churchill Green, Churchill (30mph)** in both directions from the entrance to Churchill Academy's sports fields for a distance of approximately 170m to the existing 30mph limit. **Churchill Green, Churchill (40mph)** in both directions from its junction with Sandmead Road, Sandford for a distance of approximately 580m to the entrance to Yew Tree House, Churchill Green. **Sandmead Road, Sandford (40mph)** in both directions from its junction with Nye Road, Sandford to its junction with Churchill Green, Churchill. **Nye Road, Sandford (40mph)** in both directions from the existing 30mph speed limit extents northwest for a distance of approximately 25m.
