

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14
Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2021
Church Lane, Backwell, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2021
Date coming into force: 30 January 2021
Ref: T21-33**

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Western Power Distribution to replace decayed poles (Contact Western Power Distribution 017614 051 23 or emergency 105). This will become operative on **30 January 2021** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 day** in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Church Lane from the junction with Uncombe Close to the junction of Church Town. **Alternative routes** - Church Lane, Farleigh Road, Dark Lane.
