Moor Lane, Hutton, North Somerset
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2021
Date coming into force: 15 February 2021

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Wales & West Utilities Ltd to undertake replacement gas mains work (Contact Wales & West Utilities 07860 182 260 or 08009 122 999). This will become operative on **15 February 2021** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **19 days** in duration in two phases. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Moor Lane in two phases. Phase 1 at the junction of St Marys Road. Phase 2 at the junction of Holm Road. **Alternative routes** - Phase 1 diversion - Moor Lane (part unaffected), Main Road, Hutton Hill, Vereland Road, Holm Road Phase 2 diversion - Moor Lane (part unaffected), Main Road, Hutton Hill, Vereland Road, Moor Croft Road, Moor Lane.

Temporary Prohibition: of Use by Vehicles Order 2021
Date coming into force: 5 January 2021

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by BT to install new fibre optics (contact Barden Network Engineering 01454 281 627 extension 210). This will become operative on **5 January 2021** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be **1 night** in duration between approximately 7pm and 6.30am. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule – Outside Yeowood Farm, Wrington Road, Congresbury. **Alternative routes** - Wrington Road part unaffected, Iwood Lane, Stock Lane, Langford Road, Blackmoor, Half Yard, Butts Batch, Station Road, Broad Street, High Street, West Hay Road and vice versa.

Coronation Road, Hampden Road, Hill Road, Weston-super-Mare, North
Somerset
(Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles), (Temporary One Way), (No Waiting
or Loading Restriction) Order 2021
Date coming into force: 4 January 2021
Ref: T21-09**

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule One to this Notice; and to restrict, temporarily, to vehicles to a One Way restriction in Schedule Two to this Notice, and to restrict vehicles from Waiting or Loading in Schedule Three to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for access only to premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Wales & West Utilities Ltd to replace a gas main (contact Wales & West Utilities 08009 122 999 or 07860 182 260). This will become operative on **4 January 2021** for a maximum period of 18 months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in two phases which is anticipated to be of approximately **40 days** in duration. The timings of each phase are subject to the progression of the works. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule one – Closures - Phase One Coronation Road from the junction of Church Road to the junction with Hampden Road. Phase Two Coronation Road from the junction with Hampden Road southerly for approximately 110m. Hampden Road from the junction of Coronation Road to the junction with The Weind. **Schedule two – One Way Restriction** - Coronation Road Phase Two from the junction with Church Road to the junction with Hampden Road. Hill Road from the junction of Coronation Road to the junction with Hill Road and opposite property number 59. **Schedule three – Waiting and Loading Restrictions** - timings are approximate and subject to the progression of the works and as signs dictate. Coronation Road Phase One both sides of the road from the junction of Church Road to the junction of Hampden Road for approximately two weeks. Coronation Road Phase Two both sides of the road from the junction of Hampden Road southerly for approximately 110m to Footpath AX31/21/10 for approximately four weeks. Hampden Road - both sides of the road from the junction of Coronation Road to the junction of The Weind for approximately six weeks. Hill Road for both sides of the road from the junction of Coronation Road easterly for approximately 80m and six weeks. **Alternative routes** - Church Road, Spring Hill, High Street.
