**Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order**

**(FLAX BOURTON ROAD, FAILAND AREA, NORTH SOMERSET)**  
**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING & LOADING) ORDER 2020**

**Date coming Into Force: 5th December 2020**

**Notice** is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended' and of all other enabling powers, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit waiting and loading to all vehicles on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and enforcement of the restrictions.

This order is required because of the need to implement measures for public safety in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. This order will become operative on the 5th December 2020 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated in response to the Covid-19 situation. Appropriate traffic signs and/or road markings will be displayed when and where the measures are in force.

## **SCHEDULE**

<b>Flax Bourton Road (East Side)</b>	From its junction with Birchwood Drive (at the junction mouth) for approximately 20 metres in a northerly direction.
<b>Birchwood Drive (North Side)</b>	From its junction with Flax Bourton Road (at the junction mouth) for approximately 15 metres in an easterly direction.
<b>Flax Bourton Road (East Side)</b>	From its junction with Birchwood Drive (at the junction mouth) for approximately 20 metres in a southerly direction.
<b>Birchwood Drive (South Side)</b>	From its junction with Flax Bourton Road (at the junction mouth) for approximately 15 metres in an westerly direction.
