1. To close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this notice.
2. To close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 of this notice.

This order is required because of the installation of a toucan crossing at the end of Festival Way and will become operative in **early February 2021 (dates to be confirmed in a further notice)** for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the restriction may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of **six weeks** in duration between the hours of **19:00 – 06:00**.

SCHEDULE 1: ASHTON ROAD - From its junction with Long Ashton Road to its junction with A370 North bound off slip.

SCHEDULE 2: ASHTON ROAD (one-way section) – from its junction with Ashton Road to its junction with A370 Long Ashton By-pass.
