

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14
Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order
B3128 Ashton Road, Long Ashton
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles
Date coming into force: 01 February 2021
Ref: FN-FW-002**

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset District Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be:

1. To close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 1 of this notice.
2. To close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 2 of this notice.
3. To close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in Schedule 3 of this notice.

This order is required because of the installation of a toucan crossing at the end of Festival Way and became operative on the **1st February 2021** for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the restriction may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of **six weeks** in duration between the hours of **19:00 – 06:00**.

SCHEDULE 1: ASHTON ROAD - From its junction with Long Ashton Road to its junction with Long Ashton Park & Ride access road.

SCHEDULE 2: ASHTON ROAD (one-way section) – from its junction with Ashton Road to its junction with A370 Long Ashton By-pass.

SCHEDULE 3: A370 NORTH SLIP OFF ROAD – from its junction with A370 Long Ashton Bypass to its junction with Ashton Road.

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES: Long Ashton Bypass, Portishead Way, Clanage Road, Rownham Hill, Abbots Leigh Road, Beggars Bush Lane and Vice versa.
