

PUBLIC NOTICE

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – Section 14

(VARIOUS ROADS, NORTH SOMERSET)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended' and of all other enabling powers, has made an order the effect of which is to temporarily prohibit waiting to all vehicles on the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access and enforcement of the restrictions.

This order was required because of the need to implement measures for public safety in response to the Covid-19 pandemic. This order became operative on the 27th March 2021 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated in response to the Covid-19 situation. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when and where the measures are in force.

SCHEDULE
(No waiting at any time)

In Blagdon Parish:

Burrington Combe (north side)	From the cattle grid near the access to Lower Ellick Farm, for a distance of 29 metres in a western direction.
Burrington Combe (north side)	From the cattle grid near the access to Lower Ellick Farm, for a distance of 31 metres in an eastern direction.

In Burrington Parish:

The Combe (southern side)	From the clearway sign immediately west of the car park at the top of The Combe, for a distance of 116 metres in a generally easterly direction.
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In Winscombe parish:

Winscombe Hill (southern side)	From the western edge of the access to the car park adjacent to Stone Cottage, for a distance of 35 metres in a westerly direction.
Winscombe Hill (northern side)	From a point opposite the western edge of the access to the car park adjacent to Stone Cottage, for a distance of 35 metres in a westerly direction.
Winscombe Hill (northern side)	From 30mph sign for a distance of 15 metres in westerly direction
Winscombe Hill (northern side)	From a point opposite 10 metres before the eastern edge of the eastern access road to King's Wood lane to a point opposite 10 metres past the western edge of the western access road to King's Wood lane, moving in westerly direction
Winscombe Hill (southern side)	From the eastern edge of the eastern access road to Winscombe Hall Nursing Home for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.
Winscombe Hill (southern side)	Between both the eastern and western access roads leading to Winscombe Hall Nursing Home.
Winscombe Hill (southern side)	From the western edge of the western access to Winscombe Hall Nursing Home for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.
Winscombe Hill (southern side)	From the eastern edge of the gate to Garden Cottage for a distance of 10 metres in an easterly direction.
Winscombe Hill (southern side)	From the western edge of the gate to Garden Cottage for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.
Winscombe Hill (northern side)	From a point opposite 10 metres before the eastern edge of the gate to Garden Cottage to a point opposite 10 metres past the western edge of the gate to Garden Cottage, moving in westerly direction.

Winscombe Hill (southern side)	From a point 10 metres east of eastern edge of the access gate 150m west of Garden cottage, to a point 10m beyond the access gate, a distance of approximately 30 metres in an easterly direction.
Winscombe Hill (northern side)	Opposite the restriction described above.

In Wraxall & Failand parish:

Flax Bourton Road (House no. 2)	Across the driveway of No.2, extended 2 metres north and south of the dropped kerbs.
Flax Bourton Road (House no. 4)	Across the driveway of No.4, extended 2 metres north and south of the dropped kerbs.
Flax Bourton Road (House no. 12A)	Across the driveway of No.12A, extended 3.5 metres north of the dropped kerb and 2 metres south of the dropped kerb.
Flax Bourton Road (House no. 12B and 14)	Across the driveways of No.12B and 14, extended 2 metres north and south of the dropped kerbs.
Flax Bourton Road (House no. 16)	Across the access to northern driveway of No. 16, extended 2 metres north and south of the dropped kerbs.
Flax Bourton Road (House no. 16)	Across the access to southern driveway of No. 16, extended 2 metres north and south of the dropped kerbs.
Flax Bourton Road (House no. 18A and 20)	Across the driveways of No.18A and 20, extended 2 metres north and south of the dropped kerbs.
