Allocation Sheet for Gordano School

National Offer Day (1 March 2021)

Gordano School has a Published Admission Number of 336. In order to meet as many parental preferences as possible for applicants living in the school's First Geographical Area for the 2021-22 intake, the school has exceptionally agreed to take a breach intake of 54 above the Published Admission Number of 336 taking the total intake to 390.

538 preferences have been received for the school. It has, therefore been necessary to use the oversubscription criteria, as outlined below, to determine which of the applicants should be offered the places available.

The 390 available places have been offered to the following applicants:

The distance between home and school for the last child offered a place was 2.158 miles.

Update on 26 April

5 places became available due to parents not accepting the offer of a place. 20 applicants were considered for the vacancies.
