Within each of the categories listed above, priority will be given to children who will have a brother or sister at the school at the time of enrolment.

Priority within each category will then be determined by random allocation.

To admit another child to the school would cause prejudice to the provision of efficient education or the efficient use of resources by reason of 'relevant measures', i.e. measures that would be required to be taken in order to ensure that the legal limit on class sizes of



one teacher per 30 children is met at the school. Any appeals for places at the school are therefore 'infant class size prejudice cases'.
