If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the North Somerset District Council may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.

**Explanatory Statement** 

Town and Country Planning Act 1990, section 257 and paragraph 1 of schedule 14 North Somerset District Council (Part of footpath LA 21/34, Land east of roundabout At North End Road, Yatton) Public Path Diversion Order No. 2 2021

This statement is for information only and does not form part of the order

Under the provisions of S.257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 a stopping up or diversion can be authorised if it is necessary in order for development to be carried out. A notice that such an order has been made has to be advertised on the site of the path in question and in the local press. This provides an opportunity for objections or representations to be made to the proposed change.

North Somerset District Council ("the authority") has made the above-titled Order under Section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 because it is satisfied that it is necessary to stop up part of Public Footpath LA 21/34, to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission 19/P/0575/FUL, granted under Part III of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, namely:

"Proposed upgrade of the Arnolds Way and North End (B3133) junction to provide access to land east of North End Yatton (as previously approved under Outline Planning Consent Ref. 15/P/0946/O)".

The Order seeks to stop-up the Public Footpath after it has crossed the B3133 North End Road, to ensure it aligns with the new highway upgrades, including a new pedestrian footway and cycleway. The unaffected part of Public Footpath LA 21/34 will therefore terminate where it meets the new footway.

The Public Path Stopping Up Order will formally stop-up 9.5 metres of Public Footpath LA 21/34, between point A on the Order Map No. PPO 194 (grid ref. ST 42181 66664) and point B (ST 42178 66655).

The Order will come into effect only on the confirmation of the Order. Making and advertising the Order simply provides an opportunity for objections or representations to be made.

Any Objections or representations relating to the Order must be made in writing by **16**<sup>th</sup> **September** 2**021** to the Natural Environment Team, North Somerset Council, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, BS23 1UJ quoting reference PAP/PPO 194 and stating the grounds on which they are made.

If any objections are made and not withdrawn the matter will be referred to the Council's Public Rights of Way Sub-Committee, to advise that the Orders will be submitted to the Planning Inspectorate (as agent for the Secretary of State for the Environment, Food and Rural Affairs) for determination. Once submitted, the Planning Inspectorate will then appoint an Inspector who will determine whether to deal with the matter by written representations, a hearing or a public inquiry. The inspector can confirm an Order, confirm it with modifications, or refuse to confirm it. In some cases the Inspectorate may award costs against objectors. If no objections are received the Council will be able to confirm the Order itself but has no powers to modify Orders.

The right of objection to an Order is a statutory right, but it should be exercised in a reasonable manner. Only objections received during this statutory period will be forwarded to the Secretary of State.

- 3. Where immediately before the date on which the footpath is stopped up there is apparatus under, in, on, over, along or across it belonging to statutory undertakers for the purpose of carrying on their undertaking, the undertakers shall continue to have the same rights in respect of the apparatus as they then had.


