Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Cityfibre Metro Networks Ltd to install new fibre cable. This will become operative on the 13 September 2021 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 26 days in duration Mondays to Fridays 9.30hrs to 15.30hrs (excluding Bank Holidays and Weekends). Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - Hutton Moor Road– from Hornets Rugby Club to Puttingthorpe Drive. Alternative routes - Southmead Road, Locking Road, Drove Road, Winterstoke Road, Marchfields Way, Herluin Way
