

FINAL NOTICE OF INTENT

NORTH SOMERSET DISTRICT COUNCIL

(NYE ROAD/DROVE WAY SANDFORD (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

Notice is HEREBY GIVEN that on the 21st day of October 2021 North Somerset Council made the following Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect of which will be to restrict any vehicle from exceeding 40 miles per hour speed limit on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Notice:

SCHEDULE

Nye Road/Drove Way	From a point approximately 5metres east of its junction with Sandmead Road in a north-westerly direction for a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 1280metres to a point approximately 280metres west of the existing access to the Strawberry Line Cycleway/Footpath to the north side of Drove Way.
