(NYE ROAD/DROVE WAY SANDFORD)
(40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

The District Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the **1st November 2021** and may be cited as the North Somerset District Council (Nye Road/Drove way, Sandford) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2021.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3 (4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
