(A370 BRIDGWATER ROAD, BLEADON, NORTH SOMERSET)
(50MPH SPEED LIMIT) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2021

The Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and of Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 of this Order
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in Schedule 2 of this Order
3. The North Somerset District Council (A370 Bridgwater Road, Bleadon, North Somerset) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 is hereby revoked
4. This Order shall come into operation on XXrd XXXXXX 2021 and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (A370 Bridgwater Road, Bleadon, North Somerset) (50mph Speed Limit) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2021.

SCHEDULE 1

A370 Bridgwater Road from a point 266 metres north-west of its junction with Accommodation Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 600 metres.

SCHEDULE 2

A370 Bridgwater Road from the southern boundary with Somerset County Council in a generally north western direction for a distance of approximately 788 metres.
