As part of the regeneration of Weston-super-Mare's Town Centre, North Somerset Council proposes to introduce a length of prescribed one-way traffic movement on Regent Street to avoid danger to the public, to facilitate the movement of pedestrians, to prevent damage to the road and to buildings adjacent to the road, and to improve the amenities of the area through which the roads run.

Notice is HEREBY GIVEN that North Somerset Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) proposes to make an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to introduce or revocation a one-way restriction on the lengths of the following roads in Weston-super-Mare: -

- Alexandra Parade
- Regent Street
- Alexandra Gardens Link Road (East)
- Alexandra Gardens Link Road (West)
- Locking Road

The Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on \*\* of \*\*\*\*\* 202\* and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (Town Centre Area, Weston-Super-Mare) (Prescribed One-Way Traffic Movement) Order 202#.
2. No person shall, except upon the direction of a police constable in uniform or of a traffic warden, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the length of road specified in Column 1 & Column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order in a direction other than that specified in relation to that length of road in Column 3 of the said Schedule.
3. Schedule 14 of the North Somerset District Council (Various Roads, Weston-super-Mare Area, North Somerset) (General Traffic Regulation) (Consolidation) Order 2004 is hereby revoked insofar as it relates to the lengths of road detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order.

Alexandra Gardens Link Road (East)	For its entire length (between Alexandra Parade & Regent Street)	Southbound  (from a northerly direction to a southerly direction)
Alexandra Gardens Link Road (West)	For its entire length (between Alexandra Parade & Regent Street)	Northbound  (from a southerly direction to a northerly direction)
Alexandra Parade	From its junction with Orchard Street to its junction with Alfred Street	Eastbound  (from a westerly direction to an easterly direction)
Locking Road	From its junction with Walliscote Road for a distance of 172 metres in an easterly direction (to its junction with the link road between Locking Road and Alfred Street).	Westbound  (from an easterly direction to a westerly direction)
