- Outside/near No.28, Alexandra Parade (across the entire width of the carriageway) Central Point Grid Reference: 332173, 161347
- Outside/near No.38, Alexandra Parade (across the entire width of the carriageway) Central Point Grid Reference: 332233, 161325
