As part of the regeneration of Weston-super-Mare's Town Centre, North Somerset Council proposes to introduce a number of 20mph speed limits to avoid danger to the public, to facilitate the movement of pedestrians, to prevent damage to the road and to buildings adjacent to the road, and to improve the amenities of the area through which the roads run.

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL **(VARIOUS ROADS, WESTON-SUPER-MARE, NORTH SOMERSET)** **(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 202#**

Notice is HEREBY GIVEN that North Somerset Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) proposes to make an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit on the lengths of the following roads in Weston-super-Mare: -

- Walliscote Road
- Regent Street
- Locking Road
- Alexandra Parade

The Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order shall come into operation on ** of ***** 202* and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (Various Roads, Weston-super-Mare) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 202#.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.

SCHEDULE

Walliscote Road -	From a point adjacent to the northern boundary of No. 24, Walliscote Road to its junction with Locking Road & Regent Street.
Locking Road -	From its junction with Walliscote Road for a distance of 172 metres in an easterly direction (to its junction with the link road between Locking Road and Alfred Street).
Regent Street -	From its junction with Walliscote Road/ Locking Road to a point 5 metres east of the western boundary of No. 76, Regent Street.
Alexandra Parade -	From its junction with Orchard Place to its junction with Alfred Street.
