North Road, Abbots Leigh, North Somerset  
Temporary No Parking, Waiting or Loading Order 2022  
Date coming Into Force: 10 January 2022  
Ref: T22-18

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to restrict, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by National Trust to replace fence and tree trimming (Contact National Trust 01179 731 645). This will become operative on the 10 January 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the restrictions may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 5 days in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule - North Road, Abbots Leigh - no parking, waiting or loading as traffic cones/signs dictate on both sides of North Road, between the junction of A369 for approximately 350m to the boundary of property Woodfalls. Alternative routes - see One.Network

Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2022  
Date coming Into Force: 7 January 2022  
Ref: T22-22

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Openreach to install chamber and duct for new connection. This will become operative on the 7 January 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 3 days in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

St Marys Grove, Engine Lane, Netherton Wood Lane, Nailsea, North Somerset  
Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles Order 2022  
Date coming Into Force: 4 January 2022  
Ref: T22-30

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, intend to make an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of roads.

This order is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon development works by Taylor Wimpey & Barrett Homes. This will become operative on the 4 January 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 6 weeks in duration in phases. The timings of the phases are subject to change as per the progression of the works. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule: Phase One - St Marys Grove at the junction with Engine Lane to Russett Grove. Engine Lane from junction with St Marys Grove to Worcester Gardens. Netherton Wood Lane from Engine Lane to Youngwood Lane. Phase Two - Engine Lane from junction of Allington Gardens to The Brambles. Netherton Wood Lane at junction of Engine Lane southerly to Youngwood Lane. Access maintained.
