

STATEMENT OF REASONS

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES OVER 7.5 TONNES MAXIMUM GROSS WEIGHT) ORDER 2022

North Somerset Council proposes to introduce a 7.5 tonne weight limit on the lengths of Brockway, Brockway Sliproad, Friendship Lane, Heath Road, High Street, Link Road, Mizzymead Road, Nailsea Ring Road & Station Road in Nailsea, in the interest of improving access to the local amenities and pedestrian movements within the local shopping area on the High Street and the safety of the local environs.

This proposal has been made in conjunction with another proposal to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the aforementioned lengths of road.

This proposal in conjunction with the aforementioned proposal to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the aforementioned lengths of road will therefore avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road, prevent damage to the road, facilitate the passage of pedestrians, preserve the character of the roads, and improve the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
