1. ELECTION

An Election is to be held for one Parish Councillor for the above ward.

2. NOMINATION PAPERS

3. DELIVERY OF THE NOMINATION PAPERS

Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, Somerset, BS23 1UJ, on any working day after the date of this notice between 10am to 4pm but no later than 4 pm on Friday 14th January 2022.

4. POLL

If the election is contested, a poll will take place on **Thursday 10th February 2022**.

5. APPLICATIONS TO REGISTER

Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Tuesday 25th January 2022. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.

6. ABSENT VOTES

Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset, BS23 1UJ by 5pm on Wednesday 26th January 2022.

New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset, BS23 1UJ by no later than 5 pm on Wednesday 2nd February 2022.

Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Town Hall, Walliscote Grove Road, Weston-super-Mare, North Somerset, BS23 1UJ by 5pm on Thursday 10th February 2022. The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5pm on Wednesday 2nd February 2022. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5pm on Wednesday 2nd February 2022.
