(VARIOUS ROADS, CLEVEDON, NORTH SOMERSET)
(ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

The Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and of all other enabling powers after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on **th ***** 2022 and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (Various Roads, Clevedon) (One-Way Traffic) Order 2022.
2. No person shall drive or cause or permit to be driven any motor vehicle on any length of road described by the Schedule to this Order, otherwise than in the direction specified, except for pedal cycles which can travel in both directions.
3. All existing orders relating to one-way restrictions on the lengths of road affected by this order are hereby revoked.

Street	Extent	Direction
Bellevue Road	Its entire length	Southbound only
Gardens Road	Its entire length	Eastbound
Hill Road	From its junction with Marine Hill and Copse Road to its junction with Bellevue Road.	Eastbound
Seavale Road	Its entire length	Eastbound
The Beach	Its entire length	Northbound
Woodlands Road	Its entire length	Eastbound
