ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 23

PEDESTRIAN CROSSING – HERLUIN WAY/CLOVER COURT, WESTON-SUPER-MARE

Statement of Reasons

North Somerset Council intend to install a zebra crossing on HERLUIN WAY/CLOVER COURT (near Maltlands), at the site of an existing crossing point.

The zebra is designed to improve the pedestrian and cycling environment at this location and encourage these modes of transport by reducing causes of delay or concern along the route. Residents proceeding to nearby schools and shops will also benefit from the new facility.

The pedestrian crossing is proposed for the purposes of:

avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising;

for facilitating the passage on the road of any class of traffic (including pedestrians);
and,

for improving the amenities of the area through which the road runs.
