## **STATEMENT OF REASONS**

### **(WESTON-SUPER-MARE, TOWN CENTRE AREA)**

### **(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2022**

To facilitate the creation of the bus hub in Weston town centre, North Somerset Council proposes to amend the existing town centre Prohibition of Driving restrictions. This is to limit access to the bus hub to buses and coaches, and provide access to hackney carriages (when travelling from Alfred Street to Walliscote Road only).

The restrictions will restrict access to sections of Walliscote Road, Regent Street and High Street to restrict access by all traffic (except cyclists) between 12pm and 12am. Princess Royal Square and the Regent Street area (between High Street and Beach Road) will be closed to all traffic except for cyclists.

The changes will help to avoid danger to the public, to facilitate the passage of pedestrians and cyclists, and to improve the amenities of the area through which the roads run.
