

Notice of Confirmation of Order  
Highways Act 1980

North Somerset District Council

Part of Footpath LA 19/59, Between Nos. 8/10 Stanshalls Lane and Currells Lane, Felton, Winford  
Public Path Diversion Order No. 8 2020

On 30<sup>th</sup> March 2022 North Somerset Council confirmed the above Order, made under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert that part of Public Footpath LA 19/59 in the Parish of Winford within the District of North Somerset as described below:

*from* point A (grid reference ST 52220 65870) at Stanshalls Lane, running in a northerly direction for approximately 49 metres to point B (grid reference ST 52213 65919) and then in a northerly direction for approximately 50 metres to point C (grid reference ST 52206 65968);

*to* a footpath from point D (grid reference ST 52229 65877) at Stanshalls Lane running in a north, north westerly direction for approximately 47 metres to a pedestrian gate at point E (grid reference ST 52207 65918) then in a northerly direction for approximately 40 metres to point F (grid reference ST 52206 65958) and then in a northerly direction for approximately 10 metres to point C (grid reference ST 52206 65968).

The Order comes into force on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2022 but, if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question it's validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within six weeks from 6<sup>th</sup> April 2022, make an application to the High Court.

Public Path Diversion Order No. 8 2020

This Order is made by North Somerset District Council (“the authority”) under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 (“the 1980 Act”) because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of the order and of the public it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

The applicants have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order and to fund installation charges for the pedestrian gate at point E.

By this Order:

1. The public right of way over the land situated between nos. 8/10 Stanshalls Lane and Currells Lane, Felton, Winford and shown by a bold continuous line on the Map No. PPO 193 contained in this order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up on the date on which North Somerset District Council certify that work has been carried out to bring the site of the new highway mentioned in Part 2 of the Schedule into a fit condition for use by the public.
2. Notwithstanding this order Bristol Water plc and Western Power Distribution shall have the following rights over the land referred to in paragraph 1 namely: they shall for the purpose of carrying out their undertaking continue to have the same rights in respect of their apparatus as they had immediately before the date on which the footpath is diverted.
3. There shall at the end of 28 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situated between nos. 8/10 Stanshalls Lane and Currells Lane, Felton, Winford described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold broken line on the Map No. PPO 193 attached to this order.
4. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

#### Schedule 1 – Part 1 Description of Site of Existing Path or Way

That part of footpath LA 19/59 in the parish of Winford from point A (grid reference ST 52220 65870) at Stanshalls Lane, running in a northerly direction for approximately 49 metres to point B (grid reference ST 52213 65919) and then in a northerly direction for approximately 50 metres to point C (grid reference ST 52206 65968), as shown by a bold continuous line on the attached Map No. PPO 193.

#### Schedule 1 – Part 2 Description of Site of New Path or Way

A footpath from point D (grid reference ST 52229 65877) at Stanshalls Lane running in a north, north westerly direction for approximately 47 metres to a pedestrian gate at point E (grid reference ST 52207 65918) then in a northerly direction for approximately 40 metres to point F (grid reference ST 52206 65958) and then in a northerly direction for approximately 10 metres to point C (grid reference ST 52206 65968), as shown by bold broken lines on the attached Map No. PPO 193. The path will initially have a natural surface and minimum width of 0.9 metres between points D-E, then it will have a pasture surface and 2 metres width where it runs through the fields between points E-F-C.

Schedule 1 – Part 3 Limitations and Conditions

Point E (grid reference ST 52207 65918) – Pedestrian gate

The pedestrian gate specified above is to be provided to comply with BS 5709.2018 and should be considered for removal in the event that it is no longer required to prevent the ingress or egress of animals or if the land is no longer used for agricultural purposes (including forestry and the keeping of horses).

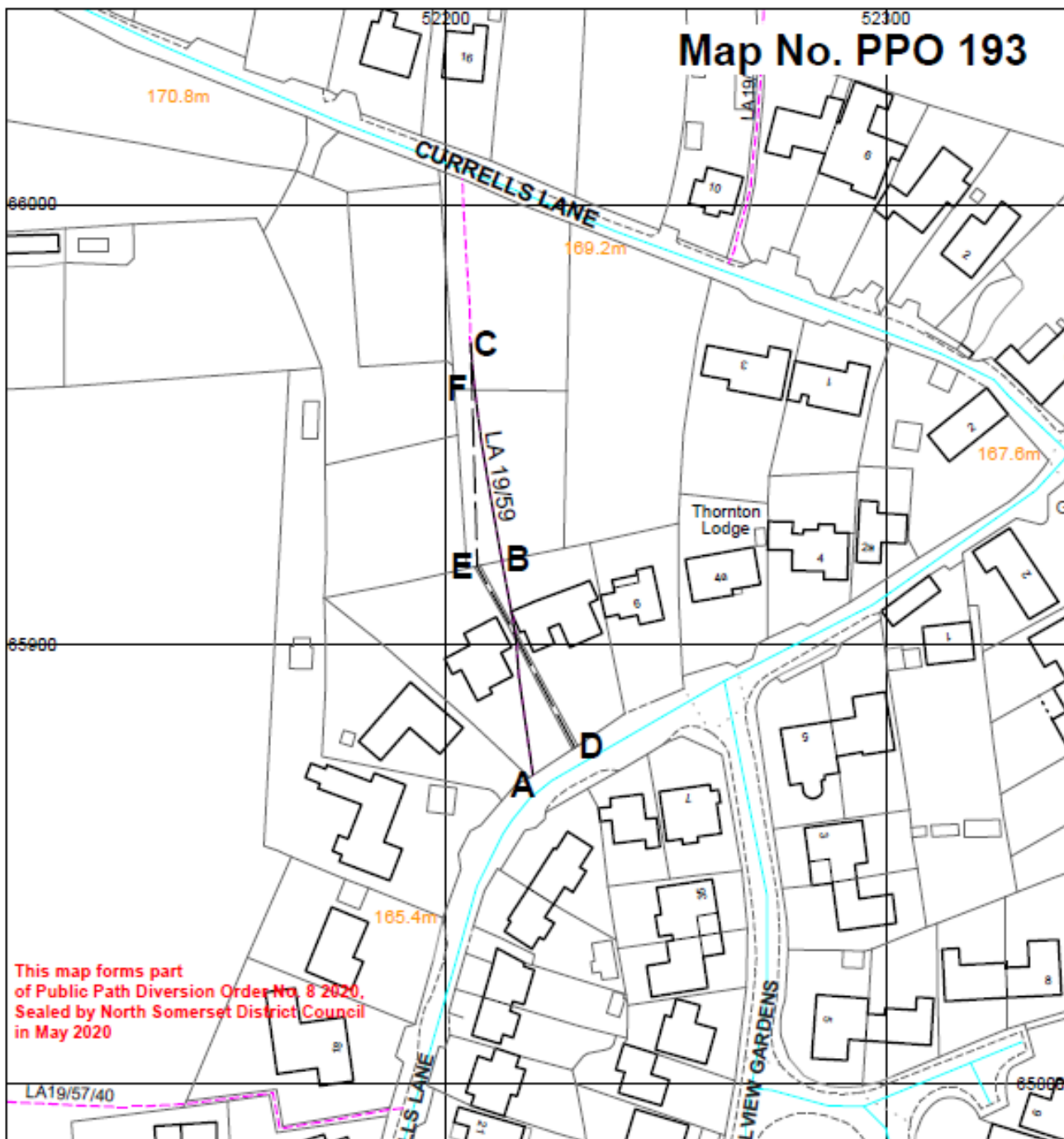
