

**FINAL NOTICE**  
**NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL**  
**(WORLE COMMERCIAL CENTRE, WESTON-SUPER-MARE**  
**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 7<sup>th</sup> April 2022, North Somerset Council made the following Order under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 as amended, the effect of which will be to impose a revised prohibition of driving restriction at the Queensway Bus Terminus (located between Queensway and Commercial Way) as specified in schedule 1 to this Notice; with an exemption for buses and vehicles used for a local authority, the Environment Agency, water/sewerage undertaker; and an emergency service vehicle.

The Order will come into operation on the 18<sup>th</sup> April 2022 and copies thereof together with plans and a copy of the Council's statement of reasons for making the Order may be inspected on North Somerset Council's website by following the QR code below or at the following website address:

**Schedule 1** (Prohibition of Driving except buses) Commercial Way from a point 150 metres north of its junction with Bristol Road to its junction with Queensway bus terminus, a distance of approximately 35 metres, and Queensway bus terminus to the lengths of road contained between its junction with Commercial Way and its junctions with Queensway.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or any provision contained in the Order on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Act of 1984, or on the grounds that any of the relevant requirements of that Act have not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks after the date on which the Order was sealed, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
