(VARIOUS ROADS, NAILSEA, NORTH SOMERSET)
(20MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 2022

The Council of North Somerset (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 30th of May 2022 and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (Various Roads, Nailsea) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2022.
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.

SCHEDULE

Mizzymead Road -	From the northernmost mini-roundabout junction arm with Stockway South to its junction with Station Road.
Station Road -	From its junction with High Street to its junction with Brockway.
Brockway Sliproad -	For its entire length.
Brockway -	For its entire length.
Nailsea Ring Road -	For its entire length.
High Street -	From its junction with Station Road to the southernmost mini-roundabout junction arm with Stock Way North.
Link Road -	For its entire length.
Heath Road -	From its junction with High Street to a point adjacent to the southern property boundary of Flats 1 – 12, Heath Gates, Heath Road.
Friendship Lane -	For its entire length.
