Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads and close temporarily to pedestrians in the footpath specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road or footpath.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Wessex Water to undertake sewer renovation works. This will become operative on the 25th July 2022 for a maximum period of six months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 12 days in duration between approximately 07.00hrs and 20.00hrs. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

Schedule: Prohibition of Vehicles - Broad Street for its full extent, Station Road from Broad Street to Butts Batch, Butts Batch from Station Road to Butts Orchard.
Prohibition of Pedestrians – Footpath AX30/79/20 Church Walk from Church View to Station Road. Alternative routes - see One.Network

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council in pursuance of the provisions of section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles the lengths of roads specified in the Schedule to this Notice. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Wales & West Utilities Ltd to upgrade gas main. This will become operative on the 25 July 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works in two phases which is anticipated to be of approximately 26 days in duration. Exemptions are included for emergency services, works access, works construction vehicles and as works permit for premises which may only be accessed via the closed section of road.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger to the public consequent upon work by Openreach to gain access to overhead lines and pole test. This will become operative on the 26 July 2022 for a maximum period of eighteen months. However, the closures may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the works which is anticipated to be of 1 day in duration between 9.30hrs and 15.30hrs.
