

**NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL**

**(STAFFORD ROAD, WESTON-SUPER-MARE) (PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES)**  
**ORDER 2022**

North Somerset Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief office of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on the XXX and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (Stafford Road, Weston-super-Mare) (Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2022.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 of this Order, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the section of road specified in Schedule 1.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to proceed along the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used by a local authority, water/sewerage undertaker; fire brigade, ambulance service or police service in pursuance of their duties, if the vehicle cannot, conveniently be used for such purposes in any other road.

**SCHEDULE 1**

**Prohibition of Vehicles**

**Stafford Road**

From its junction with Baker Street in a southerly direction for a distance measured along the said length of road of approximately 10 metres.
