## **Basic Safety Rules**

It is very important that the Borrower/s are confident in the use of the Beach Wheelchair and thoroughly familiarise themselves with their safe operation before the beginning of the loan.

- a. This wheelchair must be used under the supervision of an able-bodied adult at all times. It is not designed for self-propelling and therefore has no brakes.
- b. The manufacturer's recommended maximum weight is 22 stone (308lbs) and minimum height is 3ft tall.
- c. Do not step on the footrest during transfer as this could cause the wheelchair to tip. Raise the armrests, entering and exiting the chair from the side only.
- d. Do not use the armrests during transfer.
- e. Know your own limitations in terms of strength and endurance before attempting any manoeuvres.
- f. Do not submerge the wheelchair in water.
- g. When in hot weather, remember to use a sunscreen or umbrella to avoid sunburn. Also, the wheelchair frame can become hot.
- h. Do not allow children to stand on the bar at the back of the wheelchair.
- i. The wheelchair is designed for use on the beach where it is much easier to control than on hard surfaces. Its use on pavements should therefore be restricted to travelling to and from the Tropicana and the beach.
- j. Please ensure that the safety strap is placed comfortably around the user, clipped in and is used at all times.

## **Beach Safety**

Please take heed of all warning signs along the beach as there is no lifeguard on duty.

Do not "chase the tide line". Due to our status of having the second highest tidal range in the world, the sea does retreat a long distance when the tide is out. There is dangerous quick-sand and sinking mud. When the tide is in, the sinking mud is not exposed.
