

## Notice of Intent

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

North Somerset Council Prohibition of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2022 (Variation No.1) order 2022.

Ref: PHP/DRB/2022

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council propose to make an order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The general effect of the order shall be to amend parking restrictions (yellow lines), waiting, loading and stopping in Portishead and the Parish Council areas. The extent of the proposals are described in the Schedule to this Notice. Look for the plan reference number that is of interest, each plan has this reference. Portishead East - Brunel Court - junction with Wyndham Way, convert 1 existing disabled bay to Police Only bay (Portis01) . Finisterre Parade – junction with Phoenix Way extend existing double yellow line (Portis08). Goshawk Drive - junction with Kingfisher Road install double yellow lines (Portis 14). Phoenix Way - make permanent existing double yellow lines by numbers 150a to 138, junction of Finisterre Parade to number 207, up to 187 permanent (Portis08). Phoenix Way – make permanent existing double yellow lines in front of numbers 129 to 133 (Portis09). Phoenix Way - make permanent existing double yellow lines junction with The Martins (Portis10). Phoenix Way - make permanent existing double yellow lines outside 107 to the junction with The Finches and around the junction of The Finches (Portis10). Phoenix Way - make permanent existing double yellow lines outside number 83 and outside number 86 (Portis11). Phoenix Way - make permanent double yellow lines outside numbers 77 to 81 (Portis11). Phoenix Way - make permanent double yellow lines outside number 60 (Portis11). Phoenix Way - Fennel Road extend double yellow lines up to numbers 65 to 81 (Portis11). Phoenix Way - install double yellow lines outside number 16 Tansy Lane (Portis12). Phoenix Way - install single yellow line No Waiting 4pm - 6pm, outside number 16 Tansy Lane (Portis12). Portishead North - Beach Road West / East - junction with Woodhill Road, double yellow lines to be installed up to the drive of the vets (Portis 21). Combe Road – make legal existing double yellow lines in front of number 3 (Portis19). Ferndale Road - Install parking bays in front of number 2 4, 6 and in front of number 1 and 3 (Portis 20). Nore Gardens - Close to junction with Nore Road, install double yellow lines near bellmouth (Portis 22). Slade Road – make legal existing double yellow lines in front of number 51 (Portis17). Slade Road extend existing double yellow lines around the area of number 6 and 11 (Portis18). Stoke Road - existing limited parking bays hours of operation change to Mon - Sat 8am - 6pm 1 hour no return within 2 hours (Portis16). Portishead South - Brampton Way - Close junction with High Street, in front of Pegasus Court enforceable Limited waiting parking bay, hours of operation All days (Mon – Sun) 1 hour no return within 2 hours (Portis 23). Church Road North - install double yellow lines at the junction with Slade Road (Portis 25). Church Road North - opposite o access road to numbers 7 to 15, install double yellow lines (Portis 25). Clevedon Road - install double yellow lines from the bus stop between the two field entrance (Portis 24). Portishead West - Avon Way - existing double yellow lines in front of numbers 57 to 69, to be made enforceable (Portis 36). Blackdown Road - install double yellow lines junctions with Quantock Road and Brandon Road (Portis 29). Brendon Road - install double yellow lines junctions with Mendip Road and junction of the access road to numbers 56 to 66 (Portis 28). Friary Road - junction with West Hill, install double yellow lines (Portis 30). High View - make permanent double yellow lines outside numbers 7 and 36 and at the turning area, the corners of numbers 17 and 29 (Portis 27). Nore Road - opposite entrance to Fedden Village install double yellow lines (Portis 32). Raleigh Rise - double yellow lines between the drives of numbers 13 and 15 (Portis 31). Tower Road - make existing double yellow lines permanent, junction with High View outside number 7 (Portis 26). West Hill - junction with Nore Road, install double yellow lines (Portis 33). West Hill - extend existing double yellow lines junction with Channel View Road. Install double yellow Channel View Road, by St Barnabas Centre (Portis 34). West Hill - add double yellow lines from the access road next to number 37 (Portis 35). Wick St Lawrence and St Georges - Pastures Road - install double yellow lines in front of number 35, across the cycleway (StGeorg01). Shepherds Way / Willow Close - install double yellow lines corners of the roundabout crossroads (StGeorg02). Station Road - install double yellow lines around the bends by numbers 19 and 36 (StGeorg03). Barrow Gurney, Dundry, Flax Bourton, Winford - A38 / Freemans Quarry entrance - install double yellow lines around the junction (Barrow G01). A38 Bristol Road - from roundabout to roundabout, in front of Bristol Airport on A38, install double red lines (Winford02). Castle Close - install double yellow lines at the junction of Post Office Lane (Flax01). High Street - remove existing sign, install formal limited waiting

parking signage, Mon – Fri 9am - 5pm Sat – Sun 9am - 1 pm, 20 mins no return within 1 hour, in front of village store (Winford03). Hill Road - existing double yellow lines in the turning circle, to be made permanent (Dundry 01). West Lane - close to the junction with A38, install double yellow lines in the passing area of the cattle grid (Winford01). Wrington and Cleeve - Woodview Drive - junction with Millier Road, install double yellow lines (Cleeve01). Church Road - install limited waiting single yellow line, Mon – Sun 1pm - 1.30pm from the end of the Double yellow lines from Kinveachy to the access to the Church (Wringt01). Church Road - install limited waiting single yellow line, Mon – Sun 1pm - 1.30pm from the end of the Double yellow lines by Goblins Nook to its junction with the Pound (Wringt02). The Pound - install limited waiting single yellow line, Mon - Sun 1pm - 1.30pm from its junction with Church Road (Wringt02). Church Court - install limited waiting single yellow line, Mon – Sun 1pm - 1.30pm (Wringt02). A38 – install double yellow lines across the junction leading to Hailstones Cottages and parking bay in the layby limited to 2 hours no return in 2 hours (Wringt03). Broad Street - extend the double yellow lines across Cambridge Cottage, install a disabled bay and install a disabled bay outside Prospect House (Wringt04).
