The land to be acquired for the purposes of the Order is located in the vicinity of Banwell, North Somerset, specifically to the south-east of Court Farm and north-west of Whitecross Cottage; south-west of Towerhead Farm and north of A368 East Street; and to the north-west of Towerhead Road and south of Towerhead Brook.

New rights are being created and acquired by the Order in the vicinity of Banwell, North Somerset, specifically at the traditional orchard and hedgerow located to the north of Riverside Crescent and east of Banwell River; and at land to the north-west of Towerhead Road and south of Towerhead Brook.

This is a summary of the land and new rights to be acquired by the Order. Full details are contained within the Order available for inspection as outlined above.
