NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL
LENGTHENING OF RAISED TABLE
ON STATION ROAD, BACKWELL

North Somerset Council intends to install a zebra crossing at the site of an existing crossing point on Station Road, Backwell, and lengthen an existing raised table to enable the zebra.

The raised zebra crossing is designed to improve the pedestrian environment at this location, and to encourage this mode of transport to the nearby school and residential properties by reducing causes of delay or concern along the route.

The change to the crossing point and installation of the lengthened raised table are intended to reduce risk to persons or other traffic using the road, to facilitate the passage across the road of pedestrians, and to improve the amenity of the area through which the road runs.
