School will ask you and your parent or carers what support you need. The school will do their best to support you.



If the school, parent or carer feel you need extra support, they will request an Education Health and Care Plan.



An assessment will happen, where a professional will speak to you, your parents or carers, and the school. This will include hopes, dreams, targets, thoughts and feelings about what support you need in order to succeed.



A meeting will happen where a decision is made about whether you need an Education Health and Care Plan. Either you will need an Education Health and Care Plan, or you will have a “Way Forward Meeting”.



An Education Health and Care Plan can take 20 weeks.



Your plan will help you get the support you need.



Education Health and Care Plans will be reviewed every year.
