

# Weston Woods bike jumps code of conduct

This area of Weston Woods has been set aside by North Somerset Council for bike users to look after and use at their own risk.

The area is clearly marked by the red marker posts and fence, and users must follow this code of conduct. If breached, the council can remove permission to use this area and remove jumps as appropriate. It is important to remember and respect other users of Weston Woods while enjoying this facility.

- **Be safe** – make sure that you are using this feature in a safe manner and that others are doing the same.
- **Be tidy** - keep this area clear of obstacles and take litter away. Do not bring any other materials on site.
- **No alcohol or drugs to be taken in this area.**
- **Respect each other** - there are a range of abilities that use this area, be respectful of those honing their skills – remember, you were learning once.
- **Respect other users** of the woodland as well as not extending further into the woodland, do not ride on the paths (including Blackrock Path).
- **Avoid disturbing nature** - be aware of wildlife in this area and do not dig or pile earth around the base of trees. Do not extend the shelter beyond its current footprint or add anything to it.
- **Look after the woods** - no fires are allowed and only ride or dig within the fenced area, not on the footpaths or within the wider woodland.
- **North Somerset Council manage Weston Woods and reserve the right to remove jumps or the shelter if necessary.**
