# North Somerset District Council (Weston-super-Mare Museum) Public Space Protection Order 2023

1. This Order may be cited as the North Somerset District Council (Weston-super-Mare Museum) Public Space Protection Order 2023.

2. This Order shall commence on the date it is made and cease to be of effect on the 12 October 2026

3. This Order applies to the public spaces specified in Schedule 1 and imposes restrictions as set out in Schedule 2.

4. It is an offence for a person, without reasonable excuse:

(a) to do anything a person is prohibited from doing by schedule 2 of this order, or

(b) to fail to comply with a requirement to which the person is subject by schedule 2 of this order

5. A person guilty of an offence under condition (a) or (b) of article 4 of this order, is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or fixed penalty notice of a maximum  $\pounds$ 100.

### Schedule 1

## Public spaces within North Somerset District Council falling within the following categories

### Schedule 2

#### Restrictions

(1) No person shall

(a) cause damage to property

(b) behave in an intimidating, disorderly or indecent manner in the premises, use intimidating, abusive, offensive, insulting or obscene language therein, or intentionally or recklessly cause or do anything likely to cause injury to any other person.

(c) intentionally or recklessly obstruct any member of staff in the execution of his or her duty or intentionally or recklessly disturb, obstruct, interrupt or abuse any other person properly using the premises.

(d) intentionally display, distribute, or leave any flyer, placard, notice or other document on the premises.

(e) Intentionally view offensive and inappropriate material

(f) without consent of the manager on that day, offer anything for sale or seek donations on the premises or canvass or seek signatures for petitions.

(g) smoke including electronic cigarettes or bring into or light any flame on the premises.

(h) Except with consent of the manager on that day

(i) cause or allow any dog (other than an assistance dog) or other animal to enter or remain in the premises;

(ii) bring into any part of the premises a wheeled vehicle or conveyance [other than those necessary for the assistance of people with limited mobility], including children for which a pushchair is required.

(2) If a Police Constable or Authorised Person reasonably believes that a person has acted contrary to the restrictions placed upon them by a Public Space Protection Order, they must provide their name and address when required to do so
