North Somerset District Council (Abbots Pool) Public Space Protection Order 2023

- 1. This Order may be cited as the North Somerset District Council (Abbots Pool) Public Space Protection Order 2023
- 2. This Order shall commence on the date it is made and cease to be of effect on the 12 October 2026.
- 3. This Order applies to the public spaces specified in Schedule 1 and imposes restrictions as set out in Schedule 2.
- 4. It is an offence for a person, without reasonable excuse:
 - (a) to do anything a person is prohibited from doing by schedule 2 of this order, or
 - (b) to fail to comply with a requirement to which the person is subject by schedule 2 of this order
- 5. A person guilty of an offence under condition (a) or (b) of article 4 of this order, is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or fixed penalty notice of a maximum of £100.



Schedule 1

1. Land within the boundary of the Parish of Abbots Leigh falling within the following categories

Schedule 2

Restrictions

- (a) No person shall swim, bath, wade or jump into the water (which includes the use of boats, dinghy's, canoes, sailboards, inflatables in or on the water).
- (b) If a Police Constable or Authorised Person reasonably believes that a person has acted contrary to the restrictions placed upon them by this Order, they must provide their name and address when required to do so.
