North Somerset District Council (Ashton Court Deer Parks) Public Space Protection Order 2023

- 1. This Order may be cited as the North Somerset District Council (Ashton Court Deer Parks) Public Space Protection Order 2023.
- 2. This Order shall commence on the date it is made and cease to be of effect on the 12 October 2026.
- 3. This Order applies to the public spaces specified in Schedule 1 and imposes restrictions as set out in Schedule 2.
- 4. It is an offence for a person, without reasonable excuse:
 - (a) to do anything a person is prohibited from doing by schedule 2 of this order, or
 - (b) to fail to comply with a requirement to which the person is subject by schedule 2 of this order
- 5. A person guilty of an offence under condition (a) or (b) of article 4 of this order, is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 3 on the standard scale or fixed penalty notice of a maximum of £100.
