

NOTICE OF INTENT

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL
(WOOD HILL, CONGRESBURY, NORTH SOMERSET)
(PROHIBITED MOVEMENT) (REVOCAION) ORDER 2024

Notice is HEREBY GIVEN that North Somerset District Council proposes to make an Order under the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Traffic Management Act 2004, as amended, the effect of which will be to revoke the existing prohibited movement restrictions affecting vehicles from Wood Hill, Congresbury when turning right onto the A370 or proceeding onto Wrington Road, North Somerset.

The changes are intended to allow the Wood Hill's new signalized junction with the A370 and Wrington Road to function efficiently.
