STATEMENT OF REASONS

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, A370, CONGRESBURY, NORTH SOMERSET) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2024

As part of its approved Bus Service Improvement Plan (BSIP), North Somerset Council proposes to extend the current 30mph speed limit through Congresbury on the A370 to include the new signalized junction being implemented at the A370's junction with Wood Hill and Wrington Road. Furthermore, the speed limit on the part of Rhodyate Hill prior to the junction will be reduced to 40mph.

The proposed speed limit changes to 30mph are intended to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and the implementation of the 40mph limit is to support the changes at the A370, Wood Hill, Wrington Road junction and to help manage traffic speeds on Rhodyate Hill.
