NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL FESTIVAL WAY CROSSING IMPROVEMENTS STATEMENT OF REASONS

The introduction of a a pedestrian crossing and raised table on Trendlewood Way in Nailsea is intended to create a safer road crossing for those vulnerable road users using Festival Way.

The order is:

- for avoiding danger to persons or traffic using the road, or any other road, or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
- to facilitate the passage on the road, or any other road of any class of traffic, (this could include all types motor vehicles or other road users such as cycles or pedestrians).
- for preserving the character of the road in a case where it is specially suitable for use by persons on horseback or on foot.
- For preserving or improving air quality.
