### National Offer Day (1 March 2024)

The school has a Published Admission Number (PAN) of 336.

440 preferences have been received for the school. It has, therefore been necessary to use the oversubscription criteria, as outlined below, to determine which of the applicants should be offered the places available.

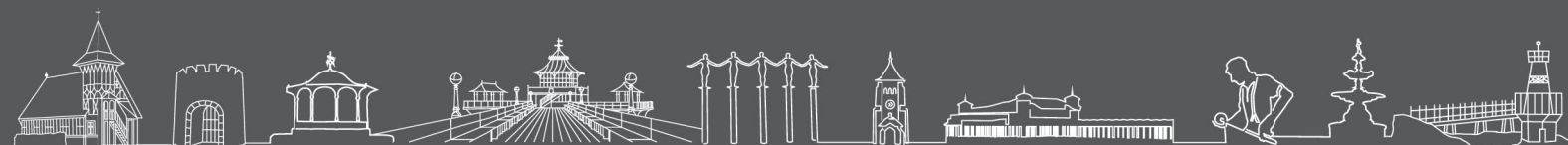
The places have been offered to the following applicants:
