## Summary of the proposed variation to the licence:

To amend conditions on annex 2 in relation to door staff numbers, as agreed with police Licensing Officer Andy Jones:

Change condition 5: A minimum of 3 SIA door staff shall be employed from 19.00 hours whenever the premises first floor is trading.

Change condition 6: Once capacity exceeds 300, additional SIA door staff shall be employed at a ratio of 1:100 or part

thereof. (Condition 7 – no change)
