**(PROHIBITION OF STOPPING, WAITING,
LOADING AND PARKING PLACES)
(CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2022 (VARIATION NO.13) ORDER 2024**

The North Somerset Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 1, 2, 4, 36, 45, 46, 49, 53 and 124, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 1984”) and the Traffic Management Act 2004 as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act of 2004”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, does hereby make the following Order:

1. THIS ORDER shall come into operation on the xxth xxxxxx 2024 and may be cited as the North Somerset Council (Prohibition of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2022 (Variation No.13) Order 2024.
2. The plans attached to this Order in hard copy form indicate the sides or lengths of roads on which the provisions of this Order apply and specify further particulars of the restrictions that are referred to in this Order. Those plans are stored on the Council’s “Streets” digital mapping system which has been used to print the hard copies attached to this Order.
3. The North Somerset Council (Prohibition of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2022 is hereby varied as follows:
 - a. The provisions and restrictions relating to the locations listed in the Schedule to this Order shall be amended as set out in the Schedule and shown in the plans attached to this Order
 - b. As regards the locations listed in the Schedule to this Order, the plans attached to this Order shall be treated as variations for the plans for those locations attached to the North Somerset Council (Prohibition of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2022

Drove Road – W-s-M	Extend existing double yellow lines up to the parking bay by the traffic lights	Map 8

Newfoundland Way - Portishead	Install 25 metres of double yellow lines on both sides of the road at the entrance to Marina Gardens	Map 2
Queenscote - Portishead	Install double yellow lines on both sides of the road from its junction with Tydeman Road for approximately 8 metres	Map 4
Tydeman Road - Portishead	Install double yellow lines on both sides of the road approximately 8 metres either side of the junction of Queenscote on both sides of the road	Map 4
Long Ashton Road – Long Ashton	Install 40 metres of double yellow lines on the south east side of the road opposite 161-165	Map 5
A38 - Churchill	Install single yellow line no parking between 12.00am – 6am in the layby both sides of the road just to the east of the village of Churchill	Map 9
Well Close - Winscombe	Install 10 metres of double yellow lines on both sides of the road at the junction with Sandford Road	Map 11
