

## **NOTICE OF INTENT**

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

**North Somerset Council Prohibition of Stopping, Waiting, Loading and Parking Places (Consolidation) Order 2022 (Variation No.13) order 2024.**

**Ref: DRB/2410/2024**

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council propose to make an order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended. The general effect of the order shall be to amend parking restrictions (yellow lines), waiting, loading and stopping in Weston-super-Mare, Portishead, Long Ashton, Churchill and Winscombe Parish Council areas. The extent of the proposals are described in the Schedule to this Notice which are split into the Parish Council Boundaries.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft Order which together with the plans, Statement of the Council's Reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at the following locations: -
